# Attendance



Attending school is very important. Your child must attend everyday. Children who are regularly absent from school miss out on opportunities which can affect their life.



**Do you know what GOOD attendance is ?** Good attendance is considered to be 96% and above. If your child drops to 90% that means they are missing  $\frac{1}{2}$  day of school per week

Only grant days at home for genuine illness – if they miraculously recover send them to school – better late than never !



Avoid taking holidays during school term

School starts at 8.52 every morning.



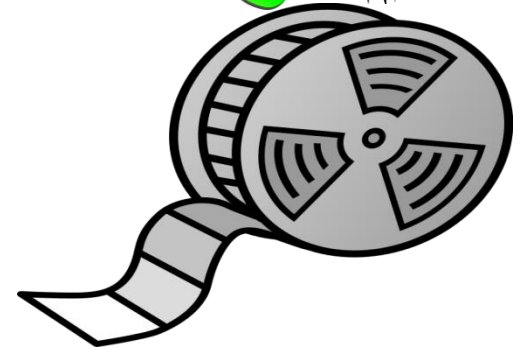
Students who are late must sign in and will get a Late Stamp.

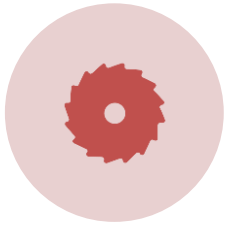

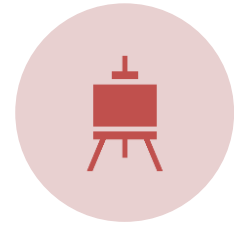
