





Attending school is very important. Your child must attend everyday. Children who are regularly absent from school miss out on opportunities which can affect their life.



Do you know what GOOD attendance is ? Good attendance is considered to be 96% and above. If your child drops to 90% that means they are missing ½ day of school per week



Attendance – What can I do?



Only grant days at home for genuine illness – if they miraculously recover send them to school – better late than never!



Avoid taking holidays during school term



Know the routine of school day ..ie PE –Tuesday



Praise and reward good attendance



Punctuality



School starts at 8.52 every morning.



Students who are late must sign in and will get a Late Stamp.



It is a legal requirement for the school to report any student who has missed 20 days or more in a school year to the statutory Educational Welfare Services of Child and Family Welfare Agency TULSA

Vouchers are available for students who need them.




